Heard Shri S.N.Gaikwad, learned counsel for the applicant and Shri A.P.Potnis, learned P.O. for the respondents.

2. Case of the applicant is as follows.

The applicant was appointed as a Peon on 27.02.2004 (Annexure A-1). Crime No.208/2017 was registered against him whereupon he was placed under suspension on 01.04.2017. By order dated 08.01.2021 (Annexure A-2) order of suspension was revoked and it was directed that the period of suspension shall be treated as duty period. By order dated 16.09.2021 (Annexure A-3) process to fill up posts of Junior Clerk by promotion from Group – D cadre started. In the list of shortlisted candidates name of the applicant was at Sr.No.26. However, in the column of remarks it was stated –

The applicant came to know that his claim for promotion was denied because of pendency of Criminal case. Against this denial he O.A.No.26/2022

made a representation (Annexure A-4). Respondent no.3, with covering letter dated 28.12.2021 (Annexure A-5), forwarded it to respondent no.2. In the matter of considering case of the applicant for promotion to the post of Junior Clerk respondent no.3 had obtained an opinion from the D.G.P., Amravati. His opinion was that since the alleged incident which had led to registration of offence/ Criminal case had no nexus with discharge of official duties the applicant could be promoted subject to the outcome of Criminal Proceeding pending against him. Hence, this O.A. for the following reliefs-

- i. allow the instant original application with costs;
- ii. be pleased to direct the respondent No.1 i.e. The Deputy Director of Health Services, Akola Division, Akola to promote the applicant on the post of Junior Clerk with immediate effect;
- iii. further be pleased to direct the respondent No.1 i.e. The

 Deputy Director of Health Services, Akola Division, Akola
 to grant deemed date of promotion from the date when
 his junior is promoted.

- iv. grant any other relief which this Hon'ble Tribunal deems fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the instant application.
- 3. In their reply at pp.21 to 25 respondents 2 to 4 have averred that the applicant was exonerated in Departmental Proceeding but the Criminal Proceeding is still pending because of which the applicant has not been promoted.
- 4. The facts stated above are not in dispute. Thus, the only question is whether on account of pendency of Criminal case promotion of the applicant can be indefinitely deferred. In view of the following rulings this question will have to be answered in the negative.

In all these judgments it is consistently held that merely on account of pendency of Criminal Case promotion cannot be indefinitely deferred. Hence, the order.

ORDER

The O.A. is allowed in the following terms.

Respondent no.2 is directed to promote the applicant to the post of Junior Clerk if he is otherwise found fit, and grant all consequential benefits within two months from today, subject, however, to the outcome of pending Criminal case. No order as to costs.
