2. The applicant retired on superannuation on 31.05.2021. He was holding the post of Medical Officer Group-A. With letter dated 07.12.2020 (Annexure A-2) respondent no.3 forwarded necessary documents to respondent no.2 so as to ensure timely release of retiral benefits of the applicant. A.G., Mumbai, issued authorisation letter dated 21.06.2021 to release amount of G.P.F.. Ultimately, retiral benefits were paid to the applicant as detailed in the following chart-

3. In these facts the applicant claims interest as provided under Rules 129-A and 129-B of the M.C.S. (Pension) Rules, 1982 on account of delayed payment.

4. Reply is not filed by the respondents.

5. Uncontroverted facts and record establish that for delayed payment the applicant was not at all responsible. Hence, the applicant would be entitled to get interest.

6. For the reasons discussed above the O.A. is allowed. Respondents are directed to pay interest to the applicant for delayed payment, as provided under Rules 129-A & 129-B of the M.C.S. (Pension) Rules, 1982- within two months from today. No order as to costs.
