2. Application has been moved by one Shri Kantrao s/o. Pagoji Dhumale who happens to be Assistant Conservator of Forests, Social Forestry Division, Nanded, District Nanded. He sought extension of time to pass order on the appeal filed by the original applicant in view of directions given by this Tribunal the O.A.No.140/2017 on the ground that respondent no.2 could not pass the order within stipulated Tribunal time as directed by the as recommendation from the respondent no.2 has been received to the office of respondent no.1 on 06-09-2017. The applicant has sought extension of 2 months' time for deciding the appeal.

- 3. I have gone through the order passed by the Tribunal in O.A.No.140/2017 dated 07-07-2017. By the said order, Tribunal had directed respondent no.1 to decide the appeal preferred by the respondent no.1 within 2 months from the date of that order.
- 4. In view of the said order Secretary had to decide the representation filed by the applicant within 2 months from the date of order dated 07-07-2017. But it is evident from the record that he failed to decide the representation In fact, respondent no.1 should within time. have approached this Tribunal seeking extension of time to decide representation mentioning grounds for not taking decision on the appeal within the prescribed period but the respondent no.1 has not approached the Tribunal and he directed the Assistant Conservator of Forests, Social Forestry Division, Nanded, District Nanded to file present Misc. Application before the Tribunal. While filing the present application, respondent no.1 has not authorized the present

applicant to file this M.A. Present applicant was also not party to the Original Application. Therefore, in view of this situation, it is evident that the present misc. application is not maintainable.

- 2. Shri Mandar Dabholkar learned Advocate has filed affidavit in reply on behalf of respondent no.5 in O.A.No.571/2017. It is taken on record. Copy thereof has been served on the other side.
- 3. On previous date learned CPO sought time to produce original file pertaining to transfers of the applicants as it is material for deciding the O.As. He had also assured to keep responsible officer in Mantralaya present before the Tribunal on today. The learned P.O. has submitted that responsible officer from Health Department has not approached him today and also not brought original record. He has submitted that presence of the responsible officer from Health Department is necessary to explain the manner in which transfers of the Civil Surgeon have been made by He has submitted that the the respondents. original record is also material to decide the O.As. Therefore, he seeks one week's time to

keep the responsible officer of Health Department present with the relevant record.

- 4. Learned Advocates for the applicants objected for granting time on the ground that on the last date respondents were directed to keep responsible officer present before the Tribunal and to provide the record as the matter has to be heard finally today. Therefore, they prayed to reject the request of the learned CPO.
- 5. On perusal of documents on record it reveals that meeting of the Civil Services Board No.1 had been alleged to be held on 16-06-2017 under the Chairmanship of one Shri Rajesh Kumar, then Principal Secretary of Health One Shri Pradeep Vyas, then Department. Commissioner and one Dr. Satish Pawar, Director of Health Services were members of the Proposal regarding transfer of the committee. Civil Surgeons might have been considered by the said committee on 16-06-2017 and they recommended transfers of the Civil Surgeons

working in the State of Maharashtra. Copy of the minutes of the meeting held by Civil Services Board No.1 had been produced on record which shows that 2 members, viz. Shri Satish Pawar and Shri Pradeep Vyas have put their signature on 16-06-2017. Shri Rajesh Kumar, Chairman had not signed the minutes but it reveals that the minutes had been signed by Dr. Pradeep Vyas again in the capacity of Chairman of the Board and also Principal Secretary of Health Department on 15-07-2017. No explanation has been given as to how Shri Pradeep Vyas put his signature on the minutes of the meeting of the Civil Services Board No.1 as a Member as well as Chairman of the committee and why the signature of Shri Rajesh Kumar had not been obtained on it. No date of meeting was mentioned in the minutes of meeting.

6. It is, therefore, just to direct Dr. Pradeep Vyas who is conversant to the fats has to explain all these irregularities noted in the minutes of the meeting by appearing personally before the

Tribunal. He is also directed to produce original file regarding transfer of the Civil Surgeons. Respondent no.1 is also directed to produce entire file of standing orders as regards transfers issued by the Chief Secretary from time to time, on the next dated.
