- 2. Learned CPO has produced communication dated 31-07-2018 received from Superintending Engineer, National Highways Circle, Aurangabad. It is taken on record and marked as document "X" for identification.
- 3. Learned Advocate for the applicant has submitted that the applicant has transferred and posted as Executive Engineer, Highways National Division, Nanded on 22-08-2016. Accordingly, he took charge of the said post on 22-08-2016. He has hardly completed 1 year and 11 months on the said post. He is not due for transfer. He has not been transferred by the respondents but the respondents issued order dated 17-07-2018

transferring the respondent no.4 on his request at the place of the applicant. It has been mentioned in the said order that separate order of transfer of the applicant will be issued. He has submitted that till today no such order is issued by the respondents and the applicant has not yet been relieved by the respondents. He has submitted that the impugned order has been issued to accommodate the respondent no.4. He has submitted that as there is no transfer order of the applicant, impugned order cannot be executed but the respondent no.4 has taken ex-parte charge of the said post on 19-07-2018. He has submitted that as the applicant has not been relieved and posted elsewhere, it is just to protect him by issuing interim relief.

4. Learned CPO has submitted that as per the communication received to him there are serious complaints against the applicant and proposal regarding his transfer has been sent to the Government and it is pending before the Government. He has submitted that in the meanwhile, Government passed the impugned

order and posted the respondent no.4 in place of the applicant. He has submitted that as per the directions of respondent nos.2 and 3, respondent no.4 took charge ex-parte of the post of the applicant on 19-07-2018 and he is working there since then. He has submitted that as respondent no.4 has joined the said post, no question of granting interim relief to the applicant arises.

- 5. On perusal of the impugned order, it reveals that by the impugned order, respondent no.4 has been transferred and posted in place of No order of transfer of the the applicant. applicant and posting elsewhere has been issued as per the said order. Not only this but till today transfer order of the applicant has not been issued. In the impugned order, in paragraph 4 it has been specifically mentioned that the controlling officer has to inform the Government about the date of relieving and date of joining of the officer who is under transfer.
- 6. On perusal of the communication received to learned CPO from Superintending Engineer, National Highways Circle, Aurangabad, it reveals

that no order regarding relieving of the applicant has been issued. Respondent no.4 took ex-parte charge of the post of the applicant.

- 7. Prima facie, it seems that applicant has not yet been relieved from the present post by the higher authorities. Therefore, it is just and proper to protect the applicant and direct the respondent no.3 not to relieve the applicant till filing of the reply by the respondents. 5. The Hon'ble High Court has directed the applicant to appear before the Caste Verification Committee. The said Committee thereafter invalidated the claim of the applicant and made following observations:-

"ORDER

- In view of the clear legal position described above and in the light of the fact that the present applicant has not been able to succeed by way of documentary evidences to prove his tribe claim as well as in the affinity test and has not been able to establish his ethnic linkage towards the Thakur, Scheduled Tribe community appeared at Sr. no. 44 in the list of Scheduled Tribes of Maharashtra. The tribe claim of the applicant Shri Chetan Yuvraj Thakur as belonging to Thakur Scheduled Tribe does not sustain and the same is held **INVALID.** The Caste Certificate issued to him by the Sub Divisional Officer Shirpur Sub Division, Shirpur, Dist. Dhule bearing R. No. 488/2000 dated 01.08.2000 is hereby cancelled and confiscated.
- 2. The Superintendent of Police, Dhule, Dist. Dhule is hereby directed to take action against the applicant as per section 10 (1) of Maharashtra Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes, V.J., N.T's Other Backward Classes and S.B. categories (Regulation of issuance and

Verification of) Caste Certificate Act 2000 (Maharashtra Act No. XXIII of 2001) and terminate his services as he has secured post of police meant for Scheduled Tribe vide your order dated 15.10.2008."

The applicant submitted that thereafter he challenged the dismissal order before the Hon'ble High Court and Hon'ble Supreme Court in which the order of Caste Verification Committee was upheld. However, the applicant could not produce the copies of those orders during the course of hearing.
