Therefore, the respondent no.1 and respondent no.1-A are called to file their own affidavit i.e. not of any subordinate officer, to state as to whether condition contained in Rule 4(v) of G.R. dated 01-07-2016 issued by respondent no.1-A stands to reason, on the ground that it tends to deprive a candidate who is duly selected from an appointment for an act of omission or lapse which is accountable to the Government and not attributable to the candidate.
