**ORAL ORDER**

The applicant is claiming relief as per prayer  
Clause-B as under:-

*“(9)(B) The Respondents may please be directed  
for release of the pension and pensionary  
benefits arising from the order dated 21.10.2014  
and 15.04.2014 below Annexure “A-1” passed  
by the Respondent No. 2 Divisional  
Commissioner, Aurangabad, including the benefit  
of Pay and allowances during the period of  
suspensions from 1.3.2012 to 20.06.2012.”*

2. Today, the learned Presenting Officer has  
placed on record one copy of communication dated

27.07.2016. It is taken on record and marked as Exhibit-X for the purposes of identification. From which it seems that the proposal was already send to the Accountant General, Nagpur but in the said proposal, it was mentioned as “उपजिल्हाधिकारी (भु स.) जायकवाडी प्रोजेक्ट विभाग ४ बीड” in fact the said reference shall be “Deputy Collector (Land Acquisition) Jayaakwadi Project No. 4 बीड हेड कॉटर अंबाजोगाई”. Only for that minor mistake, it seems that the matter is pending.

3. The respondent no. 7 is therefore, directed to depute some person and to get the said correction carried out and to see that pensionary benefits are paid to the applicant within four weeks from the date of this order.

4. In view of this direction, the Original Application stands disposed of with no order as to costs.
