order dated 3.4.2019, questions were asked by the department. These questions have been reply vide Exh.3. Questions raised, have been replied by the department vide No. आस्था-२०१७/ न्याप्र/का-४ (?)/???8 on 15.4.2019 (P.233), by which it is clear that Assistant Project Officer's pay scale is 9300-34800 plus grade pay of Rs. 4400/-. Head Master's pay scale is Rs. 9300-34800 plus grade pay of Rs. 4800/-. However, the pay scale of Secondary School Teacher is 9300-34800 plus grade pay of Rs. 4300/-. In all these posts, pay scales are same. But there is difference in grade pay. First is 4400/, then 4800/- and then 4300/-. By pleading, it appears that the Secondary

School Teachers have been appointed temporarily as Assistant Project Officer and they are overriding of the Head Master, whose grade pay is Rs. 4800/-, which is bad in law. The department should take note of it and the department should avoid junior persons to be promoted on senior post. The department may decide giving charge of the post of Assistant Project Officer (Education) to the Head Master whose pay scale is Rs. 9300-34800 plus grade pay of Rs. 4800/-.

3. The Head Master's pay scale remained protected while working as Assistant Project Officer. The department or the Government is directed to frame rules for the post of Assistant Project Officer as early as possible, maximum within a period of six months. Till that time, whatever arrangement as has been directed, it be made. With this direction the O.A. is disposed of.
