2. Today the Id. P.O. has filed reply on behalf of the respondent nos. 1, 3 & 4. It is taken on record. Copy is served to the other side.

3. During last hearing on 01.10.2021; the ld. P.O. was instructed to take instructions about compliance of the Tribunal order dated 20.08.2021. Today, the ld. P.O. submits that he is yet to receive the instructions regarding the same.

4. As per the reply filed by respondents it appears that they are going to reject the representation.

5. The ld. counsel for the applicant may file rejoinder before next date of hearing, if any.

2. As per appointment letter of applicant dated 09.01.2007 (A-1, Pg. No. 15); it is clear that applicant was appointed in open category; in the appointment letter in first line itself it is mentioned that applicant was appointed against horizontal reservation of physically challenged persons. Again applicant was promoted from Clerk to Accountant vide letter dated 23.12.2015 (A-2, Pg. No. 17) and in last column it is mentioned that he has been promoted in open category of horizontal and physically challenged quota. By both these orders, it is crystal clear that applicant was treated as open candidate and physically challenged quota from horizontal reservation quota.

3. The other employee Shri Rajkumar B. Londe was appointed vide letter dated 03.02.2004 (A-4, Pg. No. 19) and it appears from the appointment letter that he was appointed in O.B.C. category as Clerk. Shri R.B.Londe was promoted as Accountant on 03.11.2012 (A-5, Pg. No. 21) while promoting him as Accountant; it is written physically challenged against his name at Sr. No. 8. The Id. counsel for the applicant submits that when Shri R.B.Londe was appointed only against O.B.C. category how while promoting as Accountant his category was considered as physically challenged under horizontal reservation.

4. The Id. counsel for the applicant further points out that in D.P.C. meeting for Accountant to Chief Accountant dated 10.01.2020 (A-8, Pg. No. 57) on Pg. No. 60 in first part last line, it is mentioned that :-

"Jh jkt depkj ckcýko ykzął yą kki ky oMI k oufoHkkx ; kuk viak vkj {k.k var xir inktlurh nskl kBh fuoMI phr I ekfo"B dj.; kpsI ferhusBj foys" 5. In the said meeting after the list of 08 candidates; the same is reproduced below:-

6. In this situation, the ld. counsel for the applicant is directed to make Shri Londe as well as Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forest (Administration and Sub Ordinate Cadre) as respondents. Since both are not before Tribunal and both are required to be respondents for final Judgment in this O.A.. After incorporating respondents, the ld. counsel for the applicant is directed to supply the copy to the ld. P.O..

7. Till the issue is resolved about physically challenged candidates who is to be considered and who should get promotion as Head Clerk in promotion from Accountant to Chief Accountant in this category. **Respondents are directed not to promote any candidate from Accountant to Chief Accountant in the category of physically challenged quota till it is decided that who is genuine candidate to get that promotion**.

8. Issue notice to Respondents, returnable on <u>four weeks</u>. Learned P.O. waives notice for R-1. Hamdast allowed.

9. Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at this stage and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.

10. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondents intimation / notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A. Respondent is put to notice that the case would be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.

11. This intimation / notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules,1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.

12. The service may be done by Hand delivery, speed post, courier and acknowledgement be obtained and produced along with affidavit of compliance in the Registry within one week. Applicant is directed to file Affidavit of compliance and notice.

13. In case notice is not collected within <u>three days</u> and if service report on affidavit is not filed <u>three days</u> before returnable date. Original Application shall stand dismissed without reference to Tribunal and papers be consigned to record.

"(i) The application is allowed in terms of prayer clause 8 (i) and 8 (ii) and amended prayer clause no. 8 (i) (a). (ii) The respondents are directed to refund the amount of gratuity to the applicant within three months from the date of this order, failing which the applicant will be entitled to claim interest as per Maharashtra Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1982 by filing representation to that effect. No order as to costs."

3. The ld. P.O. has filed documents by which it appears that G.I.S., Leave Encashment, G.P.F. and Pension Amount have been paid and for the interest on pension is Rs. 5,31,204/- for that they have moved to Government through Deputy Director Akola Circle, Akola and for that they have asked for four months time to comply the same. Again interest of pension amount from 01.09.2005 to 17.11.2017 main amount was Rs. 2,50,000/- interest amount Rs. 4,08,788/- therefore, difference amount is Rs. 30,586/-. However, total amount of applicant is calculated Rs. 3,78,202/- as per Government order dated 30.08.2021 which is attached with letter dated 21.10.2021. For this amount of Rs. 3,78,202/- they have to go to A.G., Nagpur, it will be paid.

4. However, as submitted by Id. counsel for the applicant; it will be submitted that respondents should file on affidavit regarding all the retiral

benefits i.e. G.I.S., Leave Encashment, G.P.F., Pension etc. How it has been paid till now and what is the compliance amount to be paid and till what time it will be filed on record in the form of affidavit by respondents?

5. The Id. P.O. is directed to give all the documents zerox copy to the Administrative Officer, Amravati because he is not able to understand the facts fully. He should go through the letters and file on record in the form of affidavit.

6. The ld. counsel for the applicant has already filed pursis dated 07.12.2020 and along with that he has attached chart at Pg. No. 2 of the representation; he has contended that which amount has been paid and which are yet to be paid. While filing the affidavit; respondents should take into account pursis filed by the ld. counsel for the applicant also.
