Though he was designated as a Labour in the pay scale of Rs.2550-3200, but the respondent nos.2&3 directed him to work as a Wireless Operator from 18/3/2008 till his death. The pay scale of the post of Wireless Operator was Rs.4000-6000, whereas, he was paid salary of the post of Labour in the pay scale of Rs.2550-3200. The Government of Maharashtra Govt. G.R. dated 29/9/2003 is well known as "dkekul kj gnnk gnn; kul kj oru** (designation as per work and pay as per designation).

3. The respondent nos.2&3 moved the proposal dated 18/8/2008 to give the benefit of G.R. dated 29/9/2003 to the employees who were working on the lower posts, but discharging their work on higher posts. The similarly situated employees at Sr.Nos.23 to 27 had filed O.A.No. 175/2015 before this Tribunal. This Tribunal has directed to give the benefit of G.R. dated 29/9/2003. The respondents have complied the directions of this Tribunal in O.A. 175/2015, but denied the claim of the deceased employee Bapuji R. Mohurle.

4. The respondent nos.2&3 pointed out the another G.R. issued by the Government of Maharashtra which says that when the similarly situated employees are given the benefit of the Judgment / G.Rs. on the set of other similarly situated employees shall be given same benefits.

3. However, by record it appears that letter was issued by Industry Department on 15.03.2021 but it was received in Geology and Mining Department i.e. Respondent no. 2 on 15.03.2022. The letter was signed by one Shri Angad Kadam, Desk Officer, Mantralaya, Mumbai. It is also taken on record. Copies are served to other side. It is marked Exh.-X-1 for the purpose of identification.

4. It is surprising to note that when the letter was issued on 15.03.2021, how it was received in other department of Mantralaya on 15.03.2022, the Desk Officer owns responsibility to explain this delay and if necessary he should be called before the Tribunal to explain this time frame for reaching the letter from one department to other department in Mantralaya. Vide this letter they have submitted that D.P.C. took place on 30.12.2021 and applicant's

name has been considered for Geologist, Group-A as per recommendation of M.P.S.C. and as per date suggested by M.P.S.C. and finally it is submitted to G.A.D., after clearance from G.A.D. letter will be issued for applicant.

5. However, as submitted by Id. counsel for the applicant i.e. order dated 22.03.2022 (Mark-X-1) by Industry Energy and Employment Department. According to this, Id. counsel for the applicant submits that subordinate to applicant i.e. Juniors of applicant have been promoted vide order dated 22.03.2022. There is a lot of discrepancy regarding letter dated 15.03.2021 and received on 15.03.2022. It is also mentioned that D.P.C. took place on 30.12.2021 for Geology, Group-A and finally orders of promotions issued on 22.03.2022.

6. All these orders are creating a lot of doubt about working of department. The Id. P.O. desires two weeks time to clarify all these points and place on record documents related to that. If he does not get proper reply he should ask Shri Angad kadam, Desk Officer, Mantralaya to remain present before Tribunal and explain this discrepancy on 12.04.2022. If after two weeks issue is not settled then the Secretary of the said department will be called before this Tribunal to explain all these issues.
