Again during second D.P.C. on 05.03.2019 for the year 2018-2019 it continued. Then the third D.P.C. which was taken by Circulation on 18.11.2020 applicant case was fully covered by para 1.9 of G.R. dated 15.12.2017. Since,

from the date of 26/27.04.2017 to 18.11.2020 the duration is more than three and half years. Whearas, para 1.9 of G.R. dated 15.12.2017 becomes effective only after two years of keeping the name of applicant in sealed cover during D.P.C.."

5. Since first D.P.C. has taken place on 27.04.2021. Now, it is more than four years, whereas in para no. 1.9 of G.R. dated 15.12.2017 provides appointing authority should open sealed envelope after two years only and record the reasons for taking conscious decision about the applicant's promotion. In this case, since more than four years have passed after first D.P.C.; when applicant's name was kept in sealed envelope.

6. Respondent no. 2 is directed to use para no. 1.9 of G.R. dated 15.12.2017 and communicate the conscious decision with reasons as provided in the G.R. dated 15.12.2017 regarding promotion of the applicant to the Tribunal through Id. P.O.. This decision should be taken within sixty days from the date of this order.
