2. As pointed out by Id. counsel for the applicant; D.P.C. related to Accountant to Chief Accountant posts took place under Chairmanship of respondent no. 3 on 10.01.2020 (A-8, Pg. No. 51) at 03:00 p.m. and minutes of D.P.C. is attached from page nos. 51 to 55 (A-8). On perusal of D.P.C. meeting at page no. 54; respondent no. 5 is at Sr. No. 7 in the last table and applicant is at Sr. No. 8 in the same table; against both the candidates in the remark column it is mentioned that both are considered against physically challenged quota. However, decision has been stayed for guidance from superior office. Just above this table it is mentioned that they have asked respondent no. 2 i.e. Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forest (Administration and Subordinate Cadre) regarding promotion of respondent no. 5 and applicant in the quota of physically challenged category. Further Chief Conservator of Forest (H.R.M.) on behalf of respondent no. 2 has written to respondent no. 3 vide letter dated 06.08.2020 (A-12, Pg. No. 62) and in the said letter dated 06.08.2020 following observations have been communicated. The contents of the letter are reproduced below:-

3. Letter issued by respondent no. 2 office dated 06.08.2020 (A-12, Pg. No. 62) is very much clear that they have questioned about the promotion of respondent no. 5. Since it is pointed out that respondent no. 5 was appointed against 0.B.C. quota and not against the physically challenged quota, whereas applicant was appointed against physically challenged quota. Respondent no. 3 is directed to take into account letter issued by higher office and points raised by letter dated 06.08.2020 (A-12, Pg. No. 62) for consideration in

the minutes of D.P.C.. Further perusal of documents, it appears that there is also questions by various correspondence from respondent no. 2 vide letter dated 18.01.2020 (A-13, Pg. No. 63), (A-14, Pg. No. 64), (A-15, Pg. No. 65). (A-16, Pg. No. 66), (A-17, Pg. No. 67) and (A-18, Pg. No. 68). Finally respondent no. 2 has also directed the respondent no. 3 to take the decision on representation submitted by the applicant at A-19, Pg. No. 70 vide letter dated 12.03.2021 (A-20, Pg. No. 72).

- 4. In view of discussion in above paras, respondent no. 3 has to decide the issue of applicant as per correspondence made by respondent no. 2 within 30 days from the date of receipt of this order.
- 5. Issue notice to Respondents, returnable on <u>10.03.2022</u>. Learned P.O. waives notice for R-1. Hamdast allowed.
- 6. Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at this stage and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.
- 7. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondents intimation / notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A. Respondent is put to notice that the case would be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.
