No. 25) dated 18/02/2016. The respondent no. 3 i.e. Executive Engineer, Public Works Department No. 1, Nagpur while his letter dated 07/04/2016 (Annexure-A-9, P.B., Pg. No. 27) has acknowledged that provisional certificate has been received and further action has been taken. However, the Id. counsel for the applicant submits that further action is not taken till today as per his relief clause on P.B., Pg. No. 14 of the O.A. para no. 11 (A).

- 4. Respondents are directed to take the decision as per their own letter dated (Annexure-A-7, P.B., Pg. No. 27) within two months from the date of this order.
- 5. With this direction, **O.A.** is disposed of with no order as to costs.
- 6. **Steno copy is granted.**

2. As per the advertisement at (Annexure-R-1, P.B., Pg. No. 39) dated 01/03/2018. In the said advertisement at point no. 6 following conditions has been put. The P.O. has pointed out point no. 6 (vi) of P.B., Pg. No. 40 which is reproduced below:-

"vthkjkpspkjh=; gsfu"dyd vI.ksvko'; d vkgs; k ckcr vthkj; kuh i ksyhl foHkkxkps**pkjh=; i æk.ki =** vrhe fuoM >kyY; k menokjkl **vrhe fuoM; knh i fl/n >kY; kurj 30 fnol kps vkr** l knj dj.kscakudkjd jkghy-; k i æk.ki ækps vk/kkjp i k= menokjkyk fu; Ørh feG.; kpk vf/kdkj jkghy"

3. The Id. P.O. pointed out the admitted fact of the applicant which is at P.B., Pg. No. 7 of the O.A. in para no. VI, it is below:-

"The impugned order dated 06.11.2018 is arbitrary in nature and is thus violative of Article 14 & 16 of the constitution of India. The applicant is being discriminated on the flimsy ground of conviction under the Bombay Gambling Act. In fact the applicant was not tried and convicted, but the applicant admitted his guilt vide pursis dated 16.04.2013 and was let off by the JMFC

Samudrapur on lavying fine of Rs. 300/- vide order dated 16.04.2013. Thus the applicant is not tried and convicted but he admitted the guilt."

4. Obviously, applicant's have not fulfilled conditions of said advertisement. Considering this points, the **O.A.** is dismissed at this stage only with no order as to costs.
