2. The applicant participated in the process of selection for the post of Police Patil. In the select list dated 10.05.2023 his details feature at Sr.No.51.

3. By the impugned communication dated 12.06.2023 (Annexure A-1) he was informed that his selection was cancelled because at the time of submitting an application for the post of Police Patil he was holding a post of member of Grampanchayat.

4. It is the contention of the applicant that on 05.05.2023 he had tendered resignation of the post of member of Grampanchayat and Grampanchayat office had duly acknowledged receipt of his resignation. It is further submitted that on the same day the resignation was accepted. The factum of acceptance of resignation on 05.05.2023 is stoutly disputed by the respondents. It is pointed out that the impugned communication/order states that resignation of the applicant was accepted not on 05.05.2023 but on 16.05.2023 which was subsequent to the date of publication of select list.

5. On behalf of the applicant reliance is placed on G.R. of the Home Department, Government of Maharashtra dated 02.06.2022 (Annexure A-3). This G.R. states-

It is submitted that even if it is accepted that date of acceptance of resignation of the applicant was 16.05.2023, the G.R. lays down that while giving appointment the candidate should not hold any of the posts mentioned therein. It is reiterated that at this stage only select list is prepared and appointments are not given. It is contended that in this factual background the impugned order cannot be said to be sustainable. Prima facie there is merit in this submission. **Effect and implementation of the impugned order (Annexure A-1) shall stand stayed till the returnable date.** 

7. Issue notice to the respondents, returnable <u>after three weeks</u>. Learned P.O. waives notice for State. Hamdast allowed.

8. Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at this stage and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.

9. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondents intimation / notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A. Respondent is put to notice that the case would be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.

10. This intimation / notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules,1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.

11. The service may be done by Hand delivery, speed post, courier and acknowledgement be obtained and produced along with affidavit of compliance in the Registry within one week. Applicant is directed to file Affidavit of compliance and notice.

"3. It is submitted that, the significant communication dated 03.04.2023 of Commissioner of Police Nagpur, (City) addressed to the Respondent No. 1. The letter dated 03.04.2023, assumes much significance as it has been stated therein that, one audio clip in respect of transfer racket in the motor vehicle department has been widely made viral in the Electronic and print Media and as a consequence thereof, investigation was started by the Commissioner of Police, Nagpur (City). In this, the

Commissioner of Police, has submitted interim report dated 23.03.2023 to Principle Secretary (Transport).

In the interim report submitted by the Deputy Commissioner of Police, (EOW) on 23.03.2023, addressed to the Commissioner of Police Nagpur (City), it has been informed that, concerned Transport officers in the Motor Vehicles Department have not been co-operating in the inquiry and some witness do not come forward for recording statements before the Police Officer due to the pressure of RTO Officers."

6. Submission made by the respondents in para-3 cannot be a ground not to consider choice posting of the applicant. The Government of Maharashtra has issued G.R. dated 6/8/2002 in which it is mentioned that the employees who worked in the naxalite affected area after completion of normal tenure are entitled to get choice posting. The Government is expected to follow the said G.R. The respondents have not followed the G.R. and transferred the applicant at Ambejogai instead of giving choice posting to the applicant.

7. In view of the G.R. dated 6/8/2002, transfer of the applicant without choice posting to Ambejogai appears to be not legal and proper. The respondents should have followed the G.R. dated 6/8/2002. Hence, the following order –
