No. 108, whether that was submitted by applicant along with his original representation dated 30.06.1999 and whether that documents reached to respondent no. 3 at appropriate time or not?
- 7. The Id. C.P.O. has also relied upon the Hon'ble Apex Court Judgment in **Pramatha Nath Choudhary V. State of West Bengal, 1981 (1) SLR 570 in Civil Appeal No. 4725 of 1995 dated 21.04.1995.** As submitted by Id. counsel for the applicant he submits that the documents at P.B., Pg. 4. In view of above discussions, O.A. has no merit and requires to be dismissed. Hence, **O.A.** is dismissed with no order as to costs.
