Respondents have filed reply on 15.03.2017 3. and in para no. 3 they have mentioned Hon'ble High Court Mumbai, Bench at Aurangabad Judgment in the case of Shri Rajendra Pandurang Pagare and Another Vs. State of Maharashtra and Ors reported in the 2009 (4) Mah.L.J. 961.
