Counsel for the applicant S.L.P. was filed against this order before Hon'ble Apex Court which was dismissed. Subsequent to that Government has issued this G.R. dated 25.02.2005 and as per the direction of the G.R., C.C.F., Aurangabad issued order dated 22.11.2016 and giving Shri A.M.Katkar deemed date of appointment that documents are attached with the order of the Chief Conservator of Forest, Aurangabad. Applicant in this O.A. is squarely covered by M.A.T., Nagpur Bench, order in O.A. No. 257/2016, Government G.R. dated 25.02.2005 and order of Chief Conservator of Forest, Aurangabad letter dated 22.11.2016 (A-13, Pg. No. 276) and (A-14, Pg. No. 278) also.
