2. The issue involved is about second time employment of Ex-Servicemen. As per first employment as a Clerk (A-1, Pg. No. 14) condition no. 2 is reproduced below:-

"૨.

त्यांचीनियुक्तीहीतात्पुरतीस्वरूपाचीअसल्यानेकोणत्याह ीप्रकारचीपूर्वसूचना न देताकिंवाकोणतेहीकारण न देतात्यांचीसेवासमाप्तकरता येउ शकेल."

3. Ld. Counsel for the applicant has relied on G.R. dated 30.12.1991 and mainly in last four lines which are reproduced below:-

"परंतुज्यामाजीसैनिकांना खाजगीकंपन्या/स्वायत्तसंस्था/ सार्वजनिकउपक्रम/ शासकीय सेवा यामध्ये रोजंदारी/ कंत्राट पध्दती/ तात्पुरत्यातदर्थस्वरूपातनेमणूकामिळाल्याअसतीलआणित्यांनाअशा सेवेतूनकोणत्याहीवेळीकाढूनटाकण्याची

शक्यताअसेलअशाप्रकरणातहेआदेशलागूराहणारनाहीत.

महाराष्ट्र राज्यपाल यांच्याआदेशानुसार व नावाने."

4. It seems by record dated 08.12.2020 (A-R-2, Pg. No. 46) that applicant has been made permanent.However, ld. counsel for the applicant submits that

O.A. was filed on 28.07.2020 and letter of permanency was issued on dated 08.12.2020. The argument of the applicant is that when O.A. was filed to defeat the claim of the applicant this order was issued after five months.

5. In view of this, ld. P.O. is directed to take instructions apart from this letter that whether department has any documents which is before 28.07.2020 and proves that applicant was madepermanent. However, ld. P.O. submits that letter dated 08.12.2020 was issued after fulfilling all the conditions by the applicant to become permanent employee; it was not purposeful event to defeat the O.A..
