- 2. It is a matter of record that in the instant case Departmental enquiry was initiated when the applicant was in service. He stood retired on 30.06.2022. It is pointed out that after retirement of the applicant Inquiry Officer was appointed on 15.07.2022.
- 3. The applicant is relying on Rule 27 of the MCS (Pension) Rules, 1982 to contend that the enquiry cannot be allowed to proceed in the light of limitation of 4 years stipulated therein. The applicant is also relying on "Premnath Bali Vs. Registrar High Court of Delhi and another AIR 2016 Supreme Court 101" to contend that the time frame stipulated in this ruling has not been adhered to.
- 4. In reply it is submitted by the PO. that the matter would be covered by Rule 27(1) of the MCS (Pension) Rules and hence the limitation stipulated in Rule 27(2) will not be attracted. Still the ratio of the above referred ruling will have to be considered in the light of facts of the case.
- 5. The applicant is praying for grant of interim order that the Departmental Enquiry, in the facts and circumstances of the case, should not proceed. This is opposed by the P.O. On going through the rival submissions, Rule 27 of the MCS (Pension) Rules, 1982 and ruling "Premnath Bali" (supra) we have come to the conclusion that case is made out to pass interim order till returnable date. The Departmental Enquiry shall not be proceeded with till returnable date.
