Heard Shri V.Dongre and Shri R.V.Shiralkar, ld. Counsel for the applicant and Shri A.M.Khadatkar, ld. P.O. for the State.

2. It is submitted that chargesheet dated 04.04.2022 (A-1) is issued on allegation that the applicant had breached Rule 44(1)(i) of the Maharashtra Registration Rules, 1961. It is submitted that said Rule is interpreted in the following manner by the Hon'ble Bombay High Court in W.P. No. 2111/2022:-

"In our view, the impugned circular dated 12.07.2021, exercising the powers under Rule 44(1)(i) of the Rules being contrary to sections 34, 35 and 69 of the Registration Act, thus, deserves to be quashed and set aside. Rule 44(1)(i) of Rules deserves to be read down and not required to be followed by registering authority while registering the document under sections 34 r/w. Section 35 of the Registration Act.

In our view, the registering authority cannot refuse to register the document by placing reliance on Rule 44(1)(i) of the Rules or impugned circular dated 12.07.2021."

And in view of the above legal position further proceeding of the D.E. deserves to be stayed. After going through the chargesheet and the above referred Judgment dated 05.05.2022, I have come to

the conclusion that case is made out to stay the proceeding of D.E. started vide chargesheet dated 04.04.2022. Accordingly said proceedings are stayed till returnable date.

- 3. Issue notice to Respondents, returnable on two-weeks. Learned P.O. waives notice for R-1. Hamdast allowed.
- 4. Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at this stage and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.
- 5. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondents intimation / notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A. Respondent is put to notice that the case would be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.
- 6. This intimation / notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules,1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.
- 7. The service may be done by Hand delivery, speed post, courier and acknowledgement be obtained and produced along with affidavit of compliance in the Registry within one week. Applicant is directed to file Affidavit of compliance and notice.
- 8. In case notice is not collected within **three days** and if service report on affidavit is not filed **three days** before returnable date. Original
 Application shall stand dismissed without reference
 to Tribunal and papers be consigned to record.

2. C.A.No.399/2022 for Jt. O.A. is allowed and disposed of.

- 3. It is pointed out by Advocate Shri S.A.Marathe that by communication dated 29.03.2022 (A-14) proposal was sent to the Government for continuing services of the applicants and so far no action has been taken on the same.
- 4. It is than pointed out that by communication at A-2 it is stipulated that the applications/consent letters received after 26.09.2022 shall not be considered. This particular detail in communication is the foundation on which the applicants apprehend that serious prejudice will be caused to their prospects. So far as this detail in the communication at A-2 is concerned, ld. C.P.O. has made a statement that said date was inadvertently mentioned in the communication and a fresh communication is likely to be issued today mentioning the correct date by which applications/consent letters can be submitted. In view of this submission, presently question of grant of interim relief is not required to be considered. However, it would be open to the applicants to again pray for grant of interim relief on the returnable date if any adverse action is apprehended to be taken or taken by the respondents.

- 6. Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at this stage and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.
- 7. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondents intimation / notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A. Respondent is put to notice that the case would be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.
