" (a) Quash and set aside the enquiry report dated 11/2/2020 submitted by the respondent no.3 Enquiry Officer and consequential communication dated 21/10/2021 issued by the respondent no.2, Charity Commissioner, Mumbai.

(b) Grant any other relief deemed fit and proper in the circumstances of the case in favour of the applicant."

3. The learned counsel for the applicant submitted that the impugned show cause notice issued by the Charity Commissioner, Mumbai is illegal as the criminal case is still pending before the Special Court.

4. The learned P.O. has pointed out that departmental enquiry is complete and final show cause notice is issued, therefore, this Tribunal cannot interfere in the decision taken by the Disciplinary Authority.

5. The learned counsel relied on the Judgment of MAT, Bench at Aurangabad in O.A. 36/2015 and submitted that this Tribunal has allowed the O.A. by directing the respondents not to take any final action in furtherance of show cause notice dated 4.9/10.2014 till the decision of criminal case no.853/2012 pending against the applicant before the court of C.J.M., Nanded. Copy of the said Judgment is taken on record and marked Exh-X for identification.

6. From perusal of the inquiry report, it appears that the applicant had demanded bribe of Rs.400/- from the complainant. The applicant was caught red-handed by the ACB team at the time

demanding and accepting the bribe. The applicant is charge sheeted for the offence punishable under Sections 7,12, 13 (1) (d) with 13 (2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act,1988. The said criminal case is pending in the Special Court, Akola.

7. During pendency of the criminal case, the departmental enquiry was conducted and statement of witnesses were recorded. The Enquiry Officer has submitted his report stating the charge of corruption is proved against the applicant. The Disciplinary Authority, i.e., the Charity Commissioner has issued show cause notice as to why the applicant should not be dismissed from service. This Tribunal cannot sit on as appellate court on the action taken by the Disciplinary Authority.

8. At this stage, it is clear that charge in respect of demanding and accepting the bribe from the complainant is proved. The said cited decision is on different footing. Moreover, it is not binding on this Tribunal. It is a Judgment of the Single Bench.

9. The applicant is at liberty to take necessary action after the acquittal in the criminal case.

10. In that view of the matter, the O.A. is dismissed. No order as to costs.

According to him, in the year

2015 or at any rate in the year 2018, after she submitted succession certificate; her name ought to have been included in the wait list and ultimately recommended for giving appointment because she fulfills necessary criteria.

4. In reply, it is submitted by Ld. CPO that there is nothing on record to show that name of the applicant was included in the wait list and if her name was not included in the wait list, question of short-listing her for the purpose of giving an appointment, would not arise.

5. It is further submitted by Ld. CPO that Annexure A-5 at page No.37 i.e. representation made by the applicant to give her appointment on compassionate ground is dated 4.9.2018 and there is nothing to show that before filing this representation , she had made other representations soon after the death of her husband on 16.2.2015.

6. On considering rival submissions and record, I have come to the conclusion that the applicant is required to be protected by an interim order. Order making appointments which may be given subject to the outcome of this O.A. shall adequately protect the applicant. Appointments which may be made pursuant to communication (Annexure A-2) at page 72 shall be subject to outcome of this O.A.

 Issue notice to R-2 to 5 returnable after four weeks. Learned C.P.O. waives notice for R-1. Hamdast allowed.

8. Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at this stage and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.
