As per the order / communication dated 31/12/2018, he was appointed on the post of Chief Officer, Group-B from 8/5/2014 and he was on probation for a period two years from the date of joining i.e. 9/6/2014. He has completed two years on 9/6/2016. The applicant joined his duty as Chief Officer, Municipal Council, Jalgaon Jamod. Thereafter, he was posted at Amravati Municipal Council from 13/6/2018 to 23/07/2019 and from 24/07/2019 till date he is working as Chief Officer, Muncipal Council, Shegaon.
