- 2. The applicant was appointed as Assistant Professor in English on 6/7/1998 and her service was regularized w.e.f. 6/7/1998. It is case of the applicant that the respondent no.3 was appointed as Assistant Professor on 10/9/2007 and he was promoted as Associate Professor on 17/12/2012. It is submitted that through MPSC selection the applicant was appointed as Associate Professor in English, whereas, by virtue of ACP the respondent no.3 was promoted as Associate Professor.
- 3. I have perused the Electoral Roll which is at page no.33. In this document name of the applicant is at sr.no.1 and it is mentioned that the applicant was working as Head of the Department in English in the Government Vidarbha Institute of Science and Humanities, Amravati.
- 4. The learned counsel for the applicant submitted that the Director of Government

Vidarbha Institute of Science and Humanities, Amravati passed the order dated 13/8/2019 and without assigning any reason directed the applicant to hand over the charge of the post of Head of the Department to the respondent no.3. It is submitted that apparently the respondent no.3 is junior to the applicant and therefore the action of the Director is in violation of law. It is contention of the applicant that she has not handed over the charge as per the order dated 13/8/2019 and therefore the impugned order be stayed till filing of the reply by the respondent nos.1,2&4. After perusing the documents prima facie it is shown that the applicant was working as Head of the Department in English as she was senior to the respondent no.3. On perusal of the impugned order it seems that no satisfactory reason is recorded for taking this action, therefore, the impugned order dated 13/8/2019 be stayed till filing of the reply by the respondent nos.1,2&4.
