The applicant has insisted for Interim relief claimed in para number 9 of the O.A. for a direction to release his salary withheld by the respondents since August 2014 without a reasonable cause.

The applicant approached Hon'ble High Court in this regard by filing writ petition number 5851/2016. Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Bombay, Nagpur Bench, Nagpur vide order dated 07/10/2016 disposed of the said petition with direction to this Tribunal to decide the application for grant of Interim relief as expeditiously as possible and in any case within a period of six weeks. From the facts on record it seems that the applicant is working as Police Constable and has been declared medicallyunfit. The said medical certificate is attached with O.A. at page number 22 from which it seems that the applicant is permanently disabled. It is stated that the applicant is unable to work due to his physical condition.

It seems from the record that the applicant has earlier filed representations on 30/12/2014 and it was intimated to him vide order dated 10/12/2015 that the applicant's wife cannot be accommodated on compensation ground even if the applicant is allowed to retire on medical ground. The fact remain that the applicant is neither allowed to retire nor is able to work.

The Id. counsel for the applicant has invited my attention to proviso to section 47 of the "PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES (EQUAL OPPORTUNITIES, PROTECTION OF RIGHTS AND FULL PARTICIPATION) ACT, 1995". The said section and the relevant provision reads as under

**5.47** "Non – discrimination in government employment – (1) No establishment shall dispense with, or reduce in rank, an employee who acquires a disability during his service:

Provided that, if an employee, after acquiring disability is not suitable for the post he was holding, could be shifted to some other post with the same pay scale and service benefits:

Provided further that if it is not possible to adjust the employee against any post, he may be kept on a supernumerary post until a suitable post is available or he attains the age of superannuation, whichever is earlier.

From the aforesaid legal provisions it may be clear that even if the employee becomes completely disable and therefore unable to work, he cannot be removed from service and path is open for adjusting such employee in a suitable post or otherwise as per the provisions. Since the applicant is in service and not yet retired nor removed from service, there is no reasons as to why his salary has not been paid. The Act of 1995 a special Act and therefore the respondent cannot avoid the liability to pay the salary to the applicant.

The Id. P.O. submitted that the provisions of rule 43 of Maharashtra Civil Services (Leave) Rules are applicable to applicant's case.

Whether the applicant is entitle to such salary as per objections in para no. 5 and 6 of the reply affidavit will have to be

considered on merit at the time of final hearing.

From the discussions in foregoing paras it will be clear that the applicant is not retired, nor allowed to retire on the ground of his physical disability. His wife's claim for appointment on compassionate ground is also not considered nor he is adjusted in a suitable post as per Rule 47 of Act of 1995. He is neither dismissed nor removed from the service and hence he is very much in the service. Hence the following order:-

#### Order

The respondent is directed to release salary, as may be admissible as per rules, to the applicant from August 2014 within 04 weeks from the date of order.
