2. It is undisputed that vide order dated 27/09/2017 the applicant was appointed as Food Supply Inspector, Taluka Office, Balapur, District Akola. Before completion of normal tenure of three years all of a sudden the Divisional Commissioner, Amravati transferred the applicant vide order dated 9/8/2019 and posted him at Taluka Office Malkapur, District Buldhana. In the impugned transfer order there is no whisper as to what was the administrative exigency for premature transfer of the applicant. Apparently, the transfer is in violation and without complying the mandatory provisions under Sections 4 (4) & (5) of the Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005 (In short "Transfers Act,2005). It also appears that vide order dated 9/8/2019 the respondent no.2 modified the transfer order of Shri R.B. Wagholikar who was posted at Taluka Office, Malegaon, District Washim and after transferring the applicant from Balapur,

District Akola said Shri R.B. Wagholikar was posted at Balapur, District Akola. No doubt, the Transferring Authority is empowered to transfer a government servant before completion of the normal tenure, but as per the law this can be done after complying the mandatory provisions under Section 4 of the Transfers Act,2005. In the present case in both the transfer orders of the applicant and Shri R.B. Wagholikar it is nowhere mentioned that what was the administrative exigency for transferring both the government servants and therefore I accept the contention of the applicant that the transfer of the applicant is in violation of law and therefore the transfer order is set aside.
