- 7. In these facts and circumstances, the Original Application can be disposed of as prayed by the applicant by issuing necessary directions to respondent no. 2. Respondent no. 2 shall decide representation of the applicant dated 20.03.2023 (A-7) within six weeks from today on its own merits and by considering *inter alia* Clause B of Circular dated 09.03.2023 and Clause 12 of Notification dated 14.07.2021.
- 8. With the above directions, **O.A.** is **disposed of with no order as to costs.**

- 5. It is the grievance of the applicant that he ought not to have been subjected to frequent transfers since such practice is deprecated by the **Hon'ble Supreme Court in T.S.R. Subramanian & Ors. Vs. Union of India & Ors. (2013) 15 SCC 732.** Further reliance is placed on the judgment of this Tribunal dated 22.06.2023 in O.A. No. 1187/2022 in which *inter alia* reliance was placed on T.S.R. Subramanian & Ors. (Supra).
- 6. A statement is made that the applicant is still working at Umarkhed on the post of Naib Tahsildar.
- 7. Case is made out to stay effect and implementation of the impugned order (A-6) till returnable date. Hence, the impugned order shall stand stayed till the returnable date.
