The learned counsel for the applicant further submitted that the applicant's Govt. quarter is about 220 Sq. feet which will have to be multiplied by Rs.10/- and rent comes to be Rs.2200/- per month. But the respondents have calculated amount of rent by taking rate of Rs.100/- per Sq. feet and total of 22,000/- per month rent has been calculated and recovery is done to the tune of Rs.3,30,000/-. - 3. In response to the above advertisement applicant applied as per Annexure-A-3, P.B., Pg. No. 30 on the top it is written "Staff Nurse (Private) (50%)". The applicant was called for the examination and in the result applicant scored 156 marks and she stood at Sr. No. 7 in private 50% quota. The result was declared by Deputy Director of Health Services, Akola Circle, Akola. The publication of this result has been communicated by Respondent no. 3 to Respondent no. 2 vide letter dated 03.05.2021 (Annexure-A-7, P.B., Pg. No. 52) and in the last para it is mentioned below:-
