Adhe, learned Counsel for the Applicants and Ms S. P. Manchekar, learned Chief Presenting Officer for the Respondents</p> <p>2. The Applicant prays that his candidature be considered for the post of Police Constable (Driver) as he is eligible and entitled in the category of VJ-A Category in the recruitment pursuant to Advertisement dated 06.11.2022 issued by the Superintendent of Police, Pune (Rural).</p> <p>3. The learned Counsel for Applicant submits that Respondent No.4 vide communication dated 29.12.2023 called last candidate from 'Waiting List' for appointment as Police Constable (Driver) but he refused to accept the appointment as he had already selected in the office of Superintendent of Police, Ahmednagar. Thereafter, Applicant approached to Respondent No.3 forwarding representations dated 04.01.2024 &amp; 03.04.2024 requested to consider his candidature on the vacant post of Police Constable (Driver) because no one from 'Select List' is willing to accept the appointment and last candidate who refused to join has secured same marks i.e. 136 marks as Applicant.</p> <p>4. The office objection, if any, are to be removed and court fees to be paid, if not already paid.</p> <p>5. Issue notice before admission returnable on 10.06.2024.</p>

	<p>6. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondent intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A. Private service is allowed. Respondents are put to notice that the case may be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.</p> <p>7. This intimation/notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.</p> <p>8. By Hand delivery, speed post, courier notice to be served and acknowledgement be obtained and produced along with affidavit of compliance in the Registry within one week. Applicant is directed to file Affidavit of compliance and notice.</p> <p>9. In case notice is not collected within <u>seven</u> days or service report on affidavit is not filed <u>three</u> days before returnable date, the Original/ <del>Miscellaneous</del> Application shall be placed on board before the concerned Benches under the caption "<u>for Dismissal</u>" and thereafter on the subsequent date the Original / <del>Miscellaneous</del> Application shall stand dismissed.</p> <p>10.
