**Amendment on page No. 10**

The applicant submits that the transfer of the Respondent No.2 is de hors, the provisions of the ROT Act 2005, as the impugned transfer orders are both midterm and mid tenure and there is no compliance with the statutory provisions of Section 4(4) (ii) and 4(5) of the Transfer Act. The mandatory condition preceding the transfer order is of recording of special reasons for issuing the appeared order and that too with the prior approval of the Hon'ble

Chief Minister. In the present case, the approval of the Hon'ble Chief Minister is taken on 4/10/ 2024, i.e. after the extended time limit of general transfer 31/08/2024, no special reasons are recorded for the transfer of either the applicant or Respondent No.2. Thus the impugned order is illegal qua the Respondent No.2 and the applicant and is liable to be quashed & set aside.

**aa)** That this Hon'ble Tribunal be pleased to quash and set aside the transfer order dated 07/10/2024 by which the Respondent No.2 is transferred to the post of Deputy Commissioner (PCR), Social Welfare Department, Pune .
