Deval Shri K.B. Bhirse, the learned
Presenting Officer for the Applicants (or
Respondents) and Shri A.V. Bandiwadkar,
learned Advocate for the Respondents (or
Applicants).

Both these MAs are taken up for final
disposal. The delay in presenting the MA
573/2015 for extension of time is condoned
and MA 572/2015 is accordingly allowed.

In so far as the MA 574/2015 is
concerned, the original Respondents seek
extension of time to comply with the order of
this Tribunal. However, the learned P.O.
presents for our perusal an order issued
yesterday whereby the disciplinary authority
has modified his earlier order. The OA cannot
be allowed in terms of the directions that
the matters were remanded to the
Respondent No.1 to proceed from the stage
when the record of Enquiry Officer was
received and with directions, he was to file
the DPs against the Applicants within six
months from 26th February, 2015 which
period expired on 26th August, 2015.

Now, by an order dated 17th of
December, 2015 that the discipline
authority has made an order whereby the
proposed punishment of removal has been
substituted by the punishment of keeping the
Applicants on their basic pay of three years.
Shri Bandiwadkar has no objection to the
MA for extension of time being allowed which
in any case "Be a matter of record". The
extension as sought is hereby granted and
the MA is disposed of with no order as to
costs.
