1. Heard Shri C.T. Chandratre, the learned Counsel for the Applicant and Shri N.k. Rajpurohit, the Chief Presenting Officer for the Respondents.

2. The relief sought in this case is prayer clause no. 9(a) and 9(b), which reads as follows:

- r9(a) The Hen'ble Tribunal be pleased to call for record and proceedings of the order dated 03.12.2014 and after examining its legality and validity the same may kindly be hold as illegal and be pleased to quash and set aside the order dated 03.12.2014 along with order dated 20.12.2014.
 - 9(b) The Houble Tribunal be pleased to hold and declare that the entire period of suspension i.e. from 10.06.2004 to 05.09.2006 is required to be treated as duty period for all purposes and further be pleased to direct the Respondent to recast his pension and other retiral benefits by re fixing his pay and allowances along with payment of arrears of pay and allowances and pension within some specified period which this Hon. Tribouni deems fit."
 - 3. Learned C.P.O. for the respondents places on record the order passed by the Government of Maharashtra dated 27.01.2016 which is marked as X for the purpose of identification.
 - 4. Learned Counsel for the applicant admits that in view of the said order grievances made in prayer clause 9(a) has been redressed. However, by submits that the compliance as regards prayer clause 9(b) has not been done.
 - 5. Learned P.O. seeks four months time to comply with the prayer clause 9(b).
 - 6. In view, thereof, following order:

"The application stands disposed of with the directions that the respondents shall take steps to comply the relief claim in clause (90) within four months from the date of receipt of this order."
