Heard Shri A.V. Bandiwadekar, learned Advocate for the Applicant and Shri N.K. Rajpurohit, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.

Shri Bandiwadekar, learned Advocate for the Applicant stated that in the present O.A, the Applicant has challenged the notice proposing to impose a penalty of dismissal from service. Initially, the notice was stayed by the Tribunal. However, consequently, the order of stay was vacated. The Applicant has been given the punishment of reversion to the post of API for certain period of time. The Applicant had filed an appeal before the Government challenging the aforesaid order of reversion and sought stay, which was not granted. The Applicant had then filed another O.A. challenging the order of the State Government for not granting the stay to the order of reversion. Some order has been passed by this Tribunal in that O.A.

Learned P.O. stated that in view of the fact that the punishment has already been imposed in the D.E. against the Applicant, the present **matter has become infructuous.**
