

The gratuity having admittedly ^{been} pending this OA (see Page 37, Para 3). The dispute now remains restricted to the issue of interest which is governed by Rule 129-A of the Maharashtra Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1982.

I have perused the record and proceedings and heard Mr. M.D. Lonkar, the learned Advocate for the Applicant and Mrs. K.S. Gaikwad, the learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.

According to the Respondents, the gratuity was held up in view of the contemplated Departmental Enquiry which has not gone underway even till date. Therefore, that aspect of the matter is something which need not detain me at all.

The payment of gratuity to the extent of 90% was made on 8.11.2016 and the balance 10% on 19.11.2016. The Applicant retired on superannuation on 31.10.2015. Admittedly, even after the lapse of three months, his gratuity was not paid to the Applicant and there is no valid ground for doing so. Therefore, it is very clear that w.e.f.01.02.2016 till actual payment on 8.1.2016 and 19.11.2016, the Applicant would be entitled to the interest as provided for in Rule 129-A of the Pension Rules.

It is recorded that the Applicant, pending this OA has in accordance with his entitlement received 90% of the gratuity on 8.11.2016 and the balance 10% on 19.11.2016. The Respondents are directed to pay to him interest at the rate applicable to General Provident Fund deposits from 01.02.2016 till the date of actual payments. Compliance within six weeks from today. The OA is allowed in these terms with no order as to costs.
