## ORAL ORDER

   Applicants and Shri M.S. Mahajan learned Chief
   Presenting Officer for the respondents.
- 2. This Original Application can be disposed of without going into the merits of the case in view of the nature of the prayer, as well as, the submissions made in the affidavit filed on behalf of the Government dated 28th October, 2015. The Applicants are seeking suitable amendment to the Recruitment Rules, which will make them eligible for promotion from the post of Agricultural Assistant to the post of Agricultural Supervisor.
- 3. In the affidavit mentioned above, it is stated by the respondents that the process for amending the

Recruitment Rules is at advance stage. Learned Advocate for the Applicant states that the matter is already reached to Hon'ble Minister (Agriculture) for his approval. After that it will be placed before the Hon'ble Chief Minister and the Hon'ble Governor of Maharashtra. This should not take much time. Learned Advocate for the Applicant prayed that the respondents be directed to take complete the said process in a time bound manner.

- 4. Learned Presenting Officer states that the matter is likely to be completed within a period of six months.
- 5. Considering the aforesaid averments made by Learned Advocate for the Applicant and Learned Presenting Officer for the respondents, this O.A. is disposed of with the directions to the respondents to complete the process of amending the Recruitment Rules expeditiously, preferably within a period of six months from the date of this order.
- 6. As the Original Application No. 194/2015 itself stood disposed of today, nothing survives in the Miscellaneous

Application No. 367/2016 and hence, the same also stands disposed of.

7. There shall be no order as to costs.
